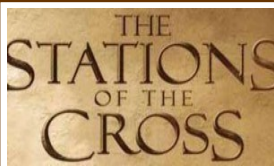

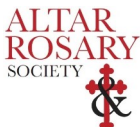
Mother & Daughter Banquet
