

COLUMBIA CATHOLIC MENTAL HEALTH MINISTRY

According to the World Health Organization, one in four people will be affected by mental health problems at some point in their lives, either through personal experience or through the diagnosis of a relative or friend.

Are you looking for ways to support a loved one? Or perhaps you are in search of answers for yourself. Would you value joining others in a conversation about mental health? Would you like to discover what God, Scripture and Church have to say in light of the experiences of mental health challenges?

If so, sign up for The Sanctuary Course for Catholics offered by the Columbia Catholic Mental Health Ministry, a collaborative effort between Holy Trinity and St. Peter parishes. The subject matter is particularly relevant in these times of heightened anxiety, and the course creates an opportunity to connect with and support each other in meaningful ways. The Sanctuary Course for Catholics is an eight-week course for small groups designed to raise awareness and start conversations in parish communities regarding mental health. It was created in collaboration with Catholic mental health professionals, theologians and clergy, and offers faith communities the opportunity to learn about mental health and grow in their ability to support members living with mental health challenges. The sessions are accompanied by compelling short films that feature the stories of Catholics living with mental health challenges, along with the insights of archbishops, theologians and psychologists.

The sessions will be held at 7:00 p.m. Wednesdays starting April 24 through June 12 at St. Peter's Parish Center. A Zoom participation option is available. Contact Deacon Jim Doyle at ccmentalhealthministry@gmail.com if you'd like to participate via Zoom.
