MENTAL HEALTH & SUICIDE PREVENTION TRAINING FOR YOUTH- MAY 10

The Columbia Catholic Mental Health and Youth Ministries, will offer Mental Health Awareness and QPR (Question, Persuade, Refer) suicide prevention training for youth on Saturday, May 10, from 10:00 AM to 3:00 PM at Holy Trinity Parish Center, 404 Cherry St., Columbia. Open to youth ages 12+ and adult counselors, the event includes a pizza lunch. Parental consent is required for participants under 18 for the QPR segment. Led by Jayne Miller, a nationally recognized mental health educator, the training equips participants to recognize signs of mental illness and suicide risk, and to respond appropriately. 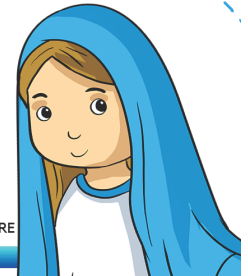
