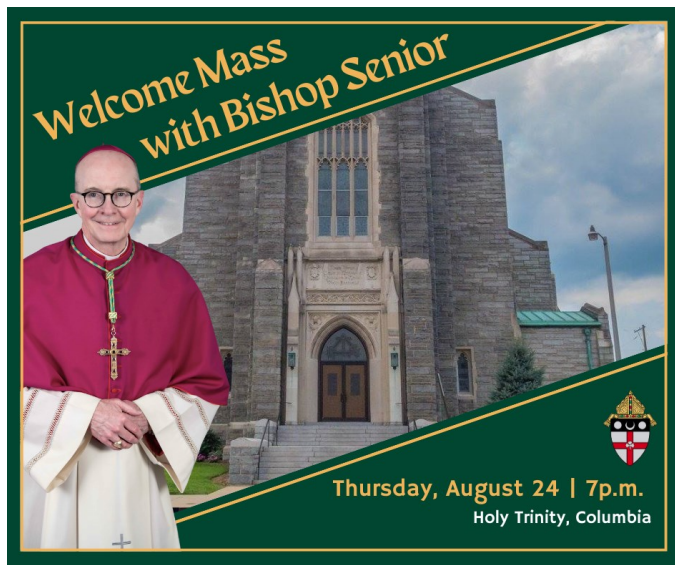

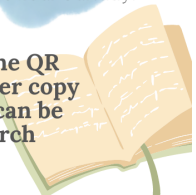
RELIGIOUS EDUCATION
