
**RELIGIOUS EDUCATION**

### **CHOIR REHEARSAL FOR BISHOP SENIOR'S WELCOME MASS**


- All who serve in parish music ministry - choir and cantors - are invited to support the singing at Bishop Senior's Welcome Mass on August 24 at 7:00 PM.
