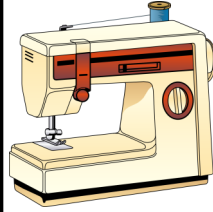

BLESSING BAGS

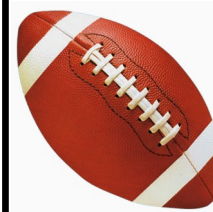
