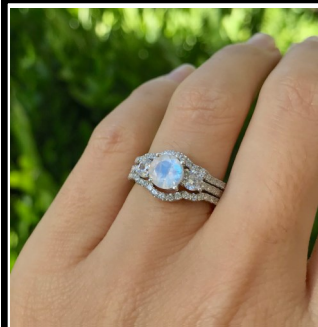
2024 PARISH CALENDARS
