

As you may have known, Russia destroyed the Khahovska dam, destroying a major drinking water supply in Ukraine. Many people in the surrounding region are left without drinking water. With your help and the help of other donors, the local churches in that area were able to hire contractors and drill wells to provide water for the local people. They also acquired water filtration equipment to make the water suitable for drinking. With your support, they were able to provide drinking water to about 500 families.
