



Message from Father Michael Grab:

By necessity, I must take this general means of communication to express my appreciation for your concern, prayers, and best wishes over Christmas and throughout the beginning of this new year. I was scheduled to provide Christmas services on a cruise ship out of Bridgetown, Barbados leaving December 21. However, on Tuesday, December 23, I was pulled off the ship at St. John, Antigua because of an aggressive gangrene infection. I had one surgery on Christmas morning, of all days, and on December 27 was airlifted to Jackson Memorial Hospital in Miami where I've had multiple, additional surgeries. On Saturday, February 7, I was airlifted to Hershey Medical Center from where I will be transferred for rehabilitation. The rehabilitation is scheduled to take place at Lancaster Nursing and Rehabilitation Center, 900 E King Street, Lancaster, PA 17602. Again, I count on your continuing prayers and good wishes as my recovery continues. **THANK YOU AND GOD BLESS YOU ALL!**


