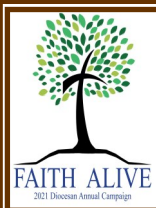

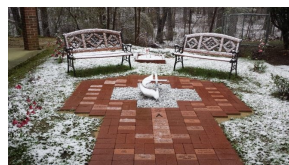


REMEMBER YOUR PARISH IN YOUR ESTATE
