St Josephine Bakhita, patron Saint of those who are victims of human trafficking, was kidnapped by Arab traders and sold into slavery where she was frequently beaten and abused, until finally sold to an Italian family and in Italy was introduced to Christianity, was baptized and subsequently obtained her freedom. As with other immigrants, she suffered from PTSD (post traumatic stress disorder) but went on to become a Canossian Daughter of Charity. Canonized in 2000, we celebrate her feast day on February 8th. Holy cards quoting her prayers, provided by CCMHM, are available in the rear of the Church.
