THE LENTEN SEASON will begin Wednesday, February 26th. As Jesus spent forty days in prayer and fasting, so we join with Him in these forty days of Lent to pray and sacrifice that God will shower his many graces upon us that we may grow in holiness. Some ways in which we can do this is by the frequent reception of the sacrament of the Eucharist through attendance at daily Mass, the reception of the sacrament of reconciliation, the reading of the Scriptures or spiritual books, praying the Stations of the Cross, taking time each day to reflect upon our relationship with God through prayer, fasting, and giving of ourselves in loving service to one another.

LENTEN REGULATIONS - (1) All Catholics **14 years of age and older** are obliged to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of the Lenten season. (2) All who are **between the ages of 18 and 59** must observe the two fasting days of Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, which means no eating between meals and the eating of one main meal and two smaller meals, that together are less than the main meal. (3) Those seriously ill are no obliged to fast during the Lenten Season.

SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION - The eighth graders of Holy Trinity and the parishes of St. Peter's and Mary, Mother of the Church will be confirmed at Holy Trinity Church on Saturday, February 29th at 10:00 am. Bishop Ronald Gainer will be celebrating this Mass.

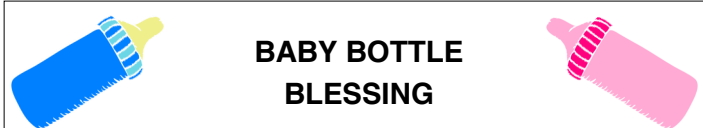
