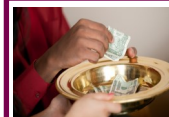

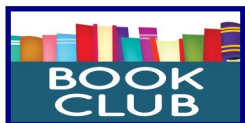

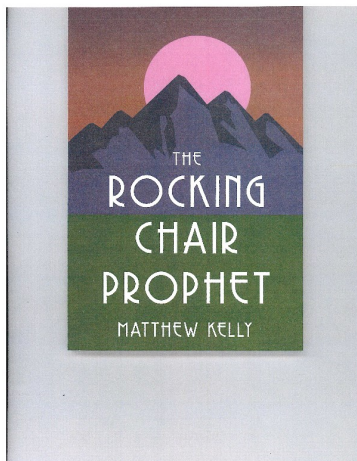

Stations of The Cross - Stations of the Cross will take place every Friday during Lent at 2:00 p.m. with the school children and again in the evening at 7:00 p.m.

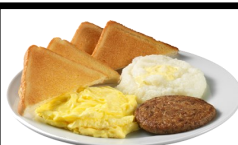
DID YOU ATTEND SACRED HEART SCHOOL? IF SO, WE NEED YOUR INPUT!

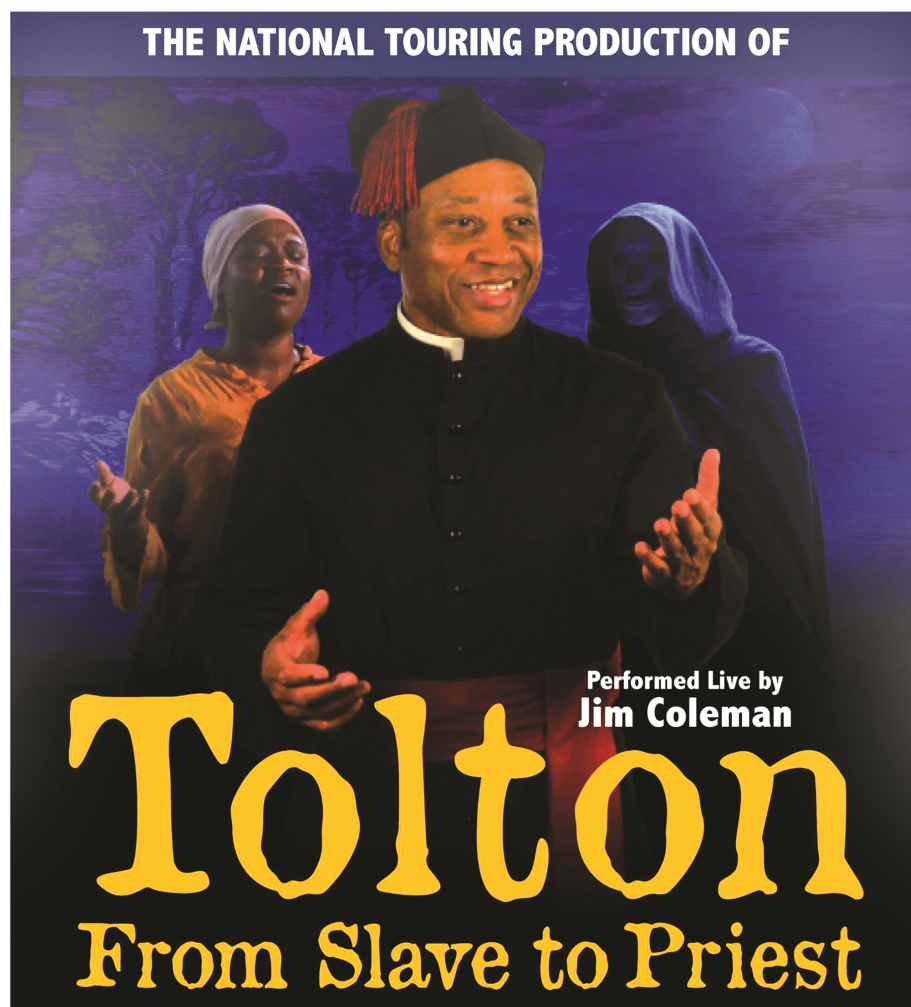
