


GET READY NOW

2023 Light of Christ Scholarship

This scholarship is open to senior students who are practicing Catholics enrolled in any high school in Lancaster or York Counties, who will be attending a two or four- year College.

There are three ways a candidate may qualify to be considered for this scholarship:

First option - your father or grandfather (living or deceased) is or was at least a 3rd Degree Knight in good standing at the Columbia Knights of Columbus #2294.

Second option – your mother or grandmother is or was a member of the Ladies' Auxiliary at the Columbia Knights of Columbus.

Third option – your father or grandfather is a member of the Holy Trinity Men's Club.

All applicants must submit a letter of recommendation addressed to the Columbia Knights of Columbus from a teacher or religious leader. You must list your educational goals, personal goals or ambitions, a brief statement of why you deserve this scholarship, school achievements and school activities and clubs, church activities and service projects, community service projects, work history and any service projects or hours served at the Columbia Council Home. Please include information starting with your freshman year until the present.
