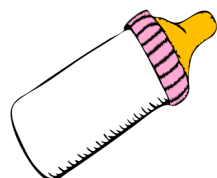


WHAT'S HAPPENING!!

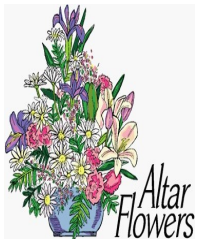
