The Columbia Catholic Mental Health Ministry will be hosting its Monthly Workshop on Wednesday, July 15th @ 7:00 PM at Our Lady of the Angels School Social Hall, 404 Cherry Street, Columbia PA, 17512 and is open to everyone in the community at no cost.

The topic of this Workshop is **Redefining Isolation When Faced with a Mental Health Diagnosis**, and will feature guest speaker **Janele Hoerner**.

Janele Hoerner, a stay-at-home mom of 9 children, explains how she has transitioned her view of isolation and separation over her lifetime. Questions will be addressed such as:

What is isolation and how do we redefine it?

How we can become more faithful to God amid a mental health diagnosis and the isolation it can bring?

How we can support those who are isolated because of their diagnosis?

How we can transform our way of thinking from an active social lifestyle into a life of caring for oneself or others at home?

In July we commemorate:

St Mark Ji Tianxiang, one of the 120 Chinese martyrs who died during the Boxer rebellion and suffered from drug addiction (July 9).

Saints Louis and Zelig Martin, parents of Thérèse of Lisieux. Louis suffered from delusions and disordered thoughts and dementia and was hospitalized at the end of his life (July 12).



Saint Camillus de Lellis, a 17th century Italian soldier addicted to gambling, who founded an order dedicated to caring for the sick (July 18).
