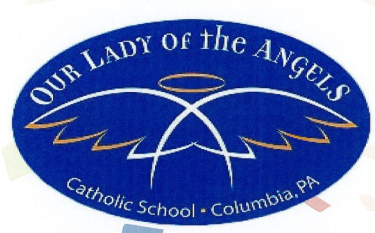

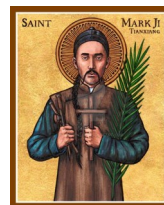

Saints Louis and Zelie Martin, parents of Thérèse of Lisieux. Louis suffered from delusions and disordered thoughts and dementia and was hospitalized at the end of his life (July 12).



Saint Camillus de Lellis, a 17th century Italian soldier addicted to gambling, who founded an order dedicated to caring for the sick (July 18).
