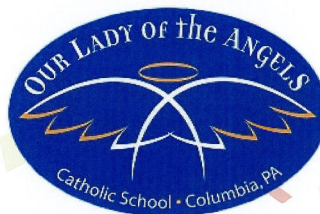
This public witness invites our community to encounter the Risen Lord. It is also our invitation for Jesus to be present in the ordinary rhythm of our daily lives.

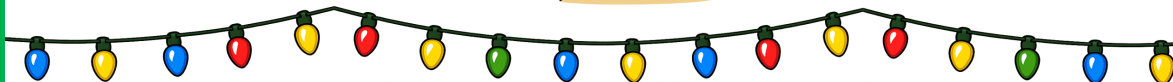

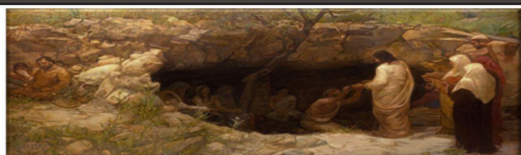
