Job Opening--Financial Administrator

The parish of St. Anne and Our Lady of La Vang is looking to hire a Financial Administrator. This individual will handle all parish bookkeeping, payroll, and other financial duties needed for parishioners, vendors, ministries, and building tenants. The position is for ten hours a week and the hours are flexible to the extent that all diocesan deadlines are met.
