Cemetery Plot Policy Update - Holy Trinity Parish has updated cemetery plot prices to ensure the long term care of the cemetery at 625 S. 9th St. Single plots are now \$2,400 in the center circle and \$2,000 elsewhere, with a portion of each sale supporting the perpetual care fund and the remainder covering maintenance costs.

During a review, several plots were found to be only partially paid. All outstanding balances must be paid by December 31, 2026. After that date, unpaid plots will return to parish ownership, with refunds issued as appropriate. The parish will make every effort to contact individuals with outstanding balances. 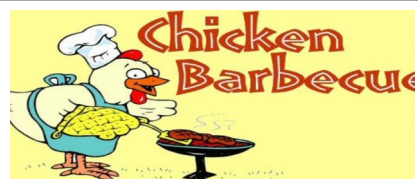
