GREEN PHASE

HOLY TRINITY CHURCH GUIDELINES

- 1. If you have concerns about your health or your vulnerability to infection, please stay home. Mass will continue to be live-streamed and recorded. Anyone coming to church who continues to have any concerns about relaxed guidelines, such as removing masks or using holy water fonts, are welcome to continue observing restrictions themselves per their own sense of personal health and protection.
- 2. Anyone who is not fully vaccinated for at least two weeks are required by diocesan policy to continue observing all the previous guidelines (masks, social distancing, etc.).

Beginning with Mass Saturday morning, May 29...

- 3. Those who have been fully vaccinated for at least two weeks may go without a mask and may forego social distancing requirements.
- 4. All pews are available. Holy Water fonts at the doors are filled and available.
- 5. Confessions will be offered in the confessional (on the left side of the church) at the usual time (3:30-4:30 pm Saturdays), or in the parish office by appointment.
- 6. The Sign of Peace is restored to the Mass. You may feel more comfortable waving than making physical contact at your discretion.
- 7. Pews do not need to be wiped down after each Mass.
- 8. The Precious Blood is still not being distributed to the faithful. Ministers distributing the Eucharist will continue to use masks and sanitizer.

No one will be asked for proof of vaccination. We are trusting each person's honesty and integrity. If you are uncomfortable with this, you may continue observing the guidelines as you desire.
