

Rising 8th-12th graders (7th-11th grade '25-'26) are invited to help with Vacation Bible School!

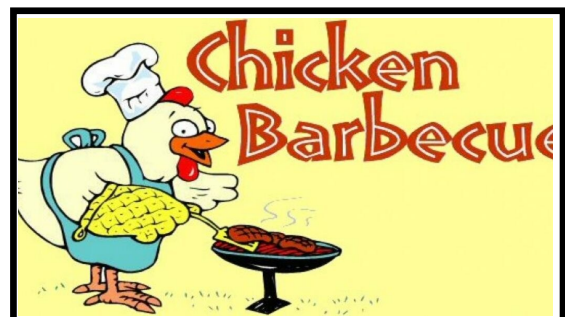
