**COMPANION ON A JOURNEY** - The St. Patrick's day party scheduled to be held on March 19th has been **CANCELLED**.



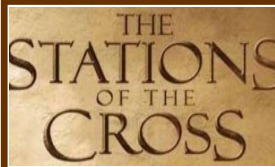

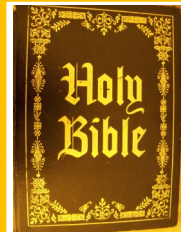
**STATIONS OF THE CROSS -**

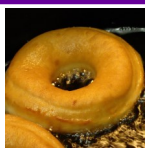
**2022 DIOCESAN ANNUAL CAMPAIGN -**

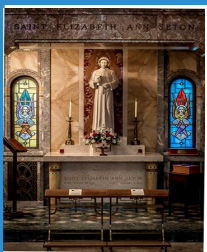
**ALUMINUM CANS** - The Men's Club is still collecting aluminum cans. Please drop them off under the archways at the school. **Please do not include plastic or trash!**

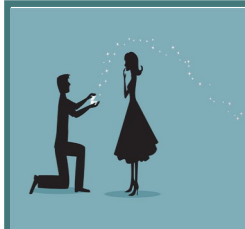
