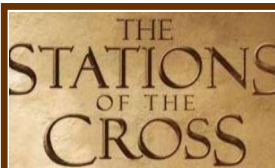

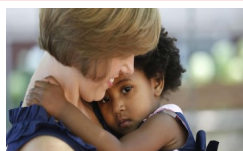
**2022 DIOCESAN ANNUAL CAMPAIGN** -

The Finance committee will meet this Wednesday, March 23 at 6:30 p.m. either by Zoom or in the lower level of the rectory.



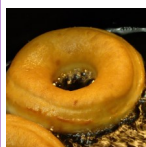
**Foster Parents Needed** -

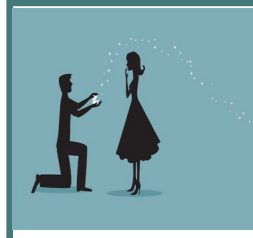
**WOMANS ANNUAL CONVENTION**

**ANNULMENT PRESENTATION**

**MARCH 22** - The Tribunal Office of the

Diocese of Harrisburg is hosting a presentation on March 22 at the Diocesan Center, 4800 Union Deposit Road, Harrisburg, concerning the Church's process of petitioning

for a declaration of nullity (annulment) of a previous marriage. The presentation begins at 7 p.m. This presentation will be valuable to anyone who wishes to marry in the Catholic Church but who is impeded by a previous marriage that ended in divorce or anyone who was married outside the Catholic Church. The presentation will cover the Church's understanding of marriage, types of annulments, the steps of the process and the grounds for marriage nullity.
