<u>2021 DIOCESAN ANNUAL CAM-</u> <u>**PAIGN**</u> - The theme for this year's DAC is "Faith Alive". Due to the pandemic, envelopes will not be put in the pews this year. Past supporters should have received a letter from Bishop Gainer at the beginning of February asking for their support for the 2021

DAC. You may respond directly to that letter by sending your gift to the Diocese, or making a gift online at www.hbgdiocese.org/DAC. It may be easier for you to budget a small gift monthly rather than a larger one time gift. Pledges can be paid over 10 months, with the last pledge payments being made in December. We partner with the Diocese to offer programs that our parish could not support independently for the benefit of parishioners like you and your family. Some examples include the commitment of the various departments within the Diocese of Harrisburg office, the support to give children a rich Catholic Education, Catholic Charities, and many other ministries and programs across our diocese. Please prayerfully consider a gift or pledge from your family that reflects the generosity that God has given to you. Please join in this effort to support both our Diocese and our parish. All gifts given by parishioners at Holy Trinity Church will count toward our parish goal of \$58,287.00.

- 1. If you have concerns about your health or your vulnerability to infection, please stay home. Mass will continue to be live-streamed and recorded.

- 6. The distribution of the Precious Blood and sharing the Sign of Peace are still omitted.
- Volunteers are needed to wipe down pews and commonly touched objects in the church after each weekend Mass.

- The hymnals have been returned to the pews. Please use them as needed for reference for the liturgical music and texts.
- 2. The ushers will resume collecting the offertory, and the gifts will be taken up to the altar by volunteers.
- Congregational singing (softly) is permitted and encouraged.
