

THE LENTEN SEASON - As Jesus spent forty days in prayer and fasting, so we join with Him in these forty days of Lent to pray and sacrifice that God will shower his many graces upon us that we may grow in holiness. Some ways in which we can do this is by the frequent reception of the sacrament of the Eucharist through attendance at daily Mass, the reception of the sacrament of reconciliation, the reading of the Scriptures or spiritual books, praying the Stations of the Cross, taking time each day to reflect upon our relationship with God through prayer, fasting, and giving of ourselves in loving service to one another.

LENTEN REGULATIONS - (1) All Catholics 14 years of age and older are obliged to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of the Lenten season. (2) All who are between the ages of 18 and 59 must observe the two fasting days of Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, which means no eating between meals and the eating of one main meal and two smaller meals, that together are less than the main meal. (3) Those seriously ill are no obliged to fast during the Lenten Season.
