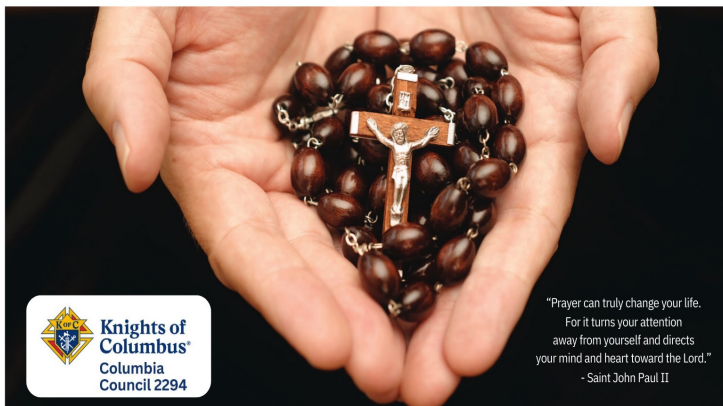
### Seek, and You Shall Find -

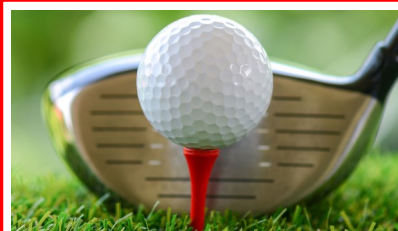
