COLLEGE BEHIND BARS - Alfred I. duPong-Columbia and Peabody-Award winning filmmaker Lynn Novick (The Vietnam War) has directed and produced a new documentary series, College Behind Bars, that reveal the transformative power of higher education through the experiences of incarcerated men and women. The four-hour series will air on WITF TV in November 2019. Distilled from nearly 400 hours of cinema-verite footage, the series explores the lives of a dozen incarcerated men and women as they struggle to earn degrees in the Bard Prison Initiative (BPI), one of the most rigorous and effective prison education programs in the country. WITF will host a free preview screening of the series followed by a community conversation about the role of Education in Pennsylvania prisons at the State Museum of Pennsylvania in Harrisburg on Tuesday, June 4th from 5:00-7:00 p.m. The event will be emceed by Scott LaMar, Host and Executive Producer of WITF's Smart Talk program. Panelists include: Lynn Novick-Filmmaker, George Little-PA Department of Corrections Executive Deputy Seretary, Terri Fazio-Education Director for PA Department of Corrections, Kate Meloney-Director of the Graterford Program at Villanova University, plus Alumni of the Bard Prison Initiative (BPI) and the Graterford Program. **VOLUNTEERS NEEDED!!!** - Faith in Action! The Diocesan Summer Camp for Adults with Intellectual & Developmental Disabilities is seeking volunteers to assist at its residential camp, August 11-16, 2019. The camp takes place at Camp Kirchenwald in Lebanon County and serves the needs of approximately 40 adults. The camp has been held annually for the past 33 years and is primarily dependent on volunteer support. Last year, volunteers from parishes throughout our Diocese participated alongside volunteers from other faith communities to help make this ministry a success. Anyone 16+ is welcome to volunteer for full-time or part-time duties; there is a particular need for male volunteers, 18+, who are able to spend the night. All volunteers are required to complete the Diocesan Clearance process and attend a brief training session prior to helping at camp. There is no cost to volunteers; all meals, event, campground activities, etc. are included. A deadline of June 30th, 2019 for expressing volunteer interest is requested in order to facilitate planning efforts.
