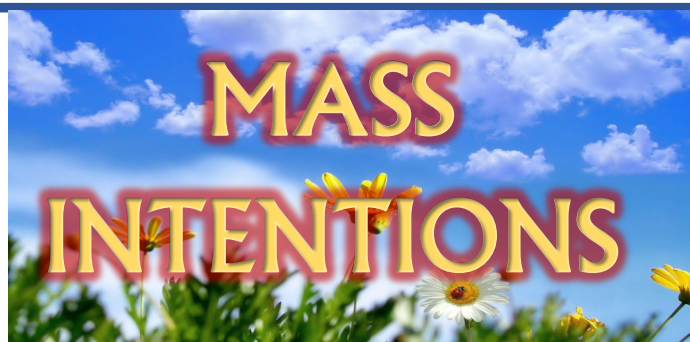

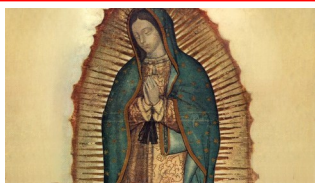

National Shrine of Our Lady of Czestochowa -

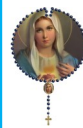
