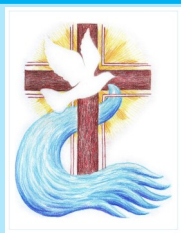

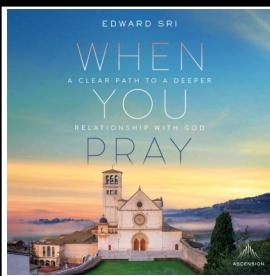



Annual Diocesan Camp at Kirchenwald Seeking Volunteers

The Diocesan Camp for Adults with Intellectual & Developmental Disabilities is held annually at Camp Kirchenwald in Lebanon County. This year's camp will be Sunday, August 9, through Friday morning, August 14, 2026. Camp Kirchenwald is staffed with adult (21+) and youth/young adult (16-20) volunteers. Volunteers are needed for this year's camp and flexible schedules are available. Volunteers can assist for the duration of camp - full-time overnight - or assist during the daytime(s) throughout the week. Provided training is mandatory and all adult volunteers (18+) must complete the required background checks, including the Diocesan Youth Protection Training (our campers are vulnerable adults that require the protections afforded to our youth). Volunteers ages 16-17 are required to take the training. Please consider joining us for this special week of service and traditional summer camp activities.
