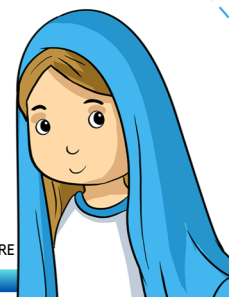

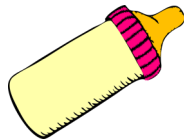
### **LANCASTER CATHOLIC CROSS COUNTRY**
