PASTORAL COUNCIL - The Pastoral Council will meet this Wednesday, November 9th at 6:30 p.m. in the lower level of the rectory.

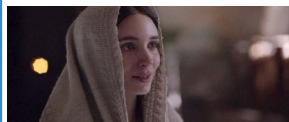


FOOD DISTRIBUTION - The next community food distribution will take place on Saturday November 12th. Workers please be there between 8:00 - 8:15

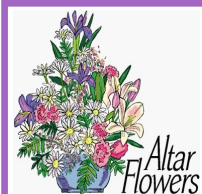

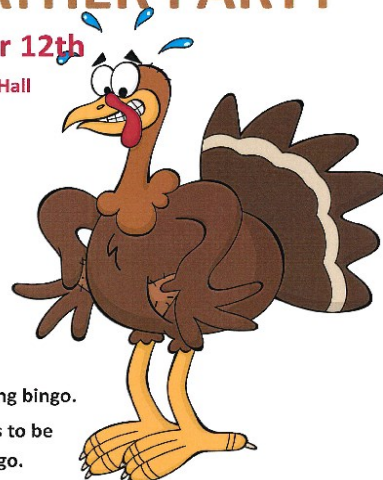
