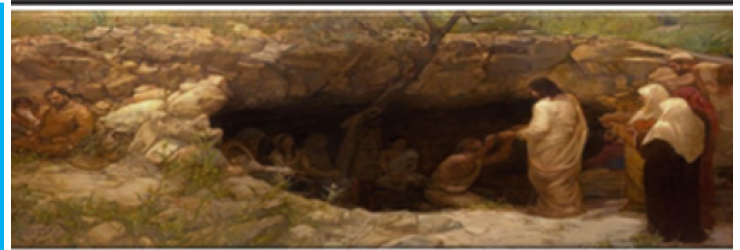

The *Columbia Catholic Mental Health Ministry* will be hosting its **monthly workshop** on **Wednesday, October 21st at 7:00 PM** at **St. Peter's Roman Catholic Church, 121 2nd Street. Columbia PA 17512 , Social Hall** and is open to everyone in the community at no cost.

The topic of this workshop is **Psychological Care: Focus on TEAM CBT & Theraplay** and will feature **guest speaker Dan Cane, EdD, NCSP**. Dr. Cane will present the uniqueness of psychological services and present components of effective psychotherapy. An emphasis will be placed on treatment monitoring and personal awakening and on the reduction of negative beliefs to address excessive suffering.

Dan Cane, EdD, NCSP is a Pennsylvania Licensed Psychologist and a Nationally Certified School Psychologist. Dr. Cane's approach is warm, empathetic, and collaborative. He emphasizes results-oriented treatment that overcomes barriers for positive lasting change.

A full parking lot is a wonderful sight to see — out of courtesy for all, please park closely together so as to allow as many as possible to take advantage of the parking lot.

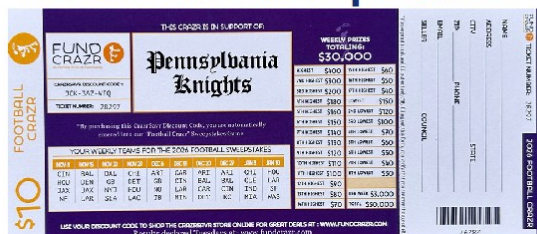

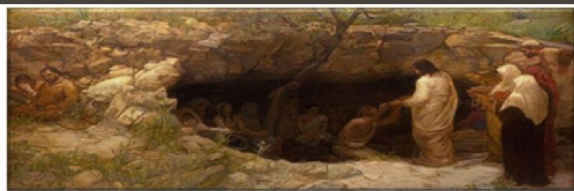
WALKING WITH PURPOSE -
