Knights Invite Families to Pray the Rosary in New Grotto

The Knights of Columbus Council 2294 will hold a Scriptural Rosary for Families at 7:00 p.m. September 19 at Our Lady of Grace Grotto, adjacent to St. Peter Church, 121 S. Second St. On May 18, more than a dozen Knights and parishioners from Holy Trinity and St.

Peter's gathered to pray the Rosary in the new grotto. At that time, Fr. Augustine Joseph, our council Chaplain, issued a challenge: come back and pray the Rosary with 50 Knights and parishioners so each person could pray one Hail Mary.

In a Scriptural Rosary, 50 verses from Sacred Scripture are recited, one before each Hail Mary. The verses for each decade correspond to the Mystery being recalled. The grotto features a cross as the centerpiece, surrounded by a Rosary created out of stones in the ground. Attendees will gather around the cross and stand next to the 50 stones. The space is wheelchair accessible and easily entered from the parking lot next to the church. Knights and their families as well as parishioners from Holy Trinity and St. Peter's are welcome.
