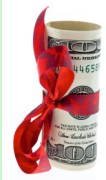
OBLIGATION TO ATTEND MASS IS RESTORED

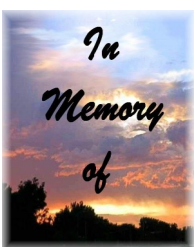
REMEMBER YOUR PARISH IN YOUR ESTATE
