FORTY HOURS EUCHARISTIC DEVOTIONS

Our parish Forty Hours Devotions begins with Eucharistic exposition at the end of the 10:30 a.m. Mass on Sunday September 30, and after the 7:30 a.m. Mass Monday, October 1 and Tuesday, October 2. Each evening at 7:00 p.m., there will be a liturgical service with songs, psalms, readings, and a guest homilist, ending with Eucharistic Benediction. This year's quest homilist is Deacon David Hall.
